## WHO KNEW?

## VALENTINE'S DAY EDITION

- According to Hallmark, 145 million cards are sent each year on Valentine's Day, and that doesn't include kids' valentines at school.
- The first recorded Valentine's letter, written by Charles, Duke of Orleans, was penned in 1415. When he was 21, Charles wrote to his wife while he was imprisoned in the Tower of London. One of the more famous lines in his love letter reads, "I am already sick of love, My very gentle Valentine." The letter is currently on display at the British Library in London.
- By some estimates, as many as 250 million roses are grown in anticipation of Valentine's Day every year. Countries such as Kenya, Columbia, and Ecuador grow the flowers and ship them to countries with cooler February climates for the holiday, as roses only grow in warmer temperatures.
- The first heart-shaped candy box was introduced in 1862 by Richard Cadbury, son of chocolatier and Cadbury founder John Cadbury. Today, upwards of 36 million heart-shaped boxes of chocolates are sold each year accounting for a whopping 58 million pounds of chocolate.
